THE WINE:

80% Treixadura and 20% Torrontés from the Galicia region of Northwest Spain; stainless steel fermentation and maturation with no oak.

THE ESTATE:

Vineyards are 35 miles from the Atlantic coast of Spain just north of the Portuguese border in the province of Pontevedra, Spain. The sandy, acidic soil in this region causes low yields with a very concentrated grape. The winery produces 140,000 bottles per year.
