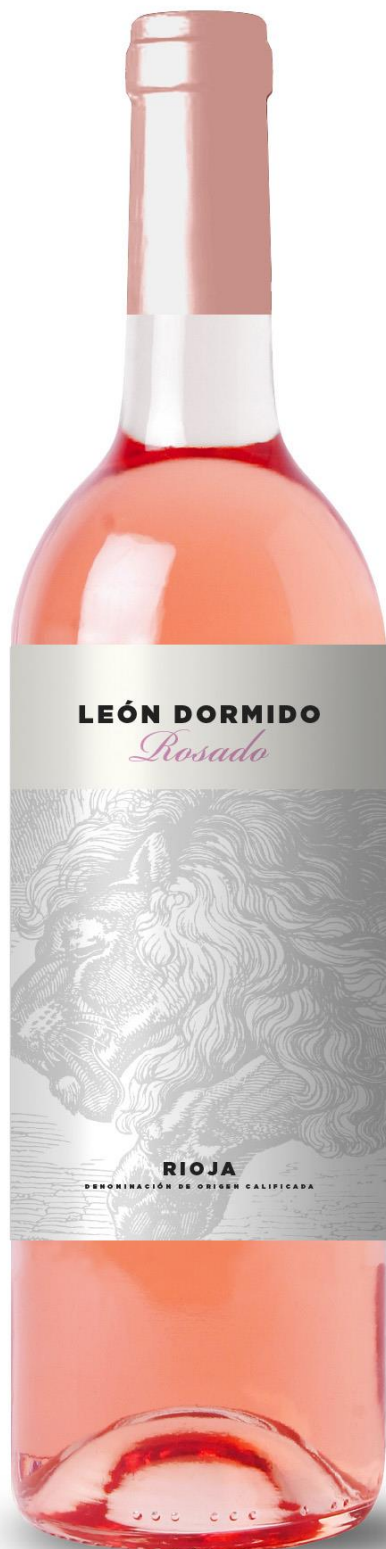


2014 LEON DORMIDO ROSADO

RIOJA, SPAIN



THE WINE:

100% Garnacha (Grenache) from a single vineyard near the town of Badarán. Gently pressed with very limited skin contact to preserve freshness. The soil is very rich in iron imparting a mineral component to the wine.

THE ESTATE:

Leon Dormido wines are all hand-crafted by Miguel Merino Navajas. Named for the famous mountain in Rioja (“Sleeping Lion”) these small production wines are all fruit focused; a departure from the heavily oaked wines of Rioja’s past. Miguel’s deep knowledge and passion for the native Tempranillo and Garnacha grapes are on full display.

TASTING NOTES:

Color. A true bright pink.

Aromas. Raspberry and red cherry aromas with a whisper of orange peel.

Flavors. Delicate and fresh with subtle berry fruit and cranberry. Notes of mineral on the crisp, dry and clean finish.

Food Pairing. Summer salads or a fresh fruit and cheese platter.
