

# 2021 Domaine Haegi Pinot Blanc Domaine Haegi, Alsace, France



## **The Wine:**

100% single vineyard Pinot Blanc from 35-year-old vines. Hand harvested, double sorted. The juice was fermented and aged in stainless steel. 400 cases produced. Biodynamic methods used during the growing season and no pesticides. Certified as organic wine, Vin Biologique, by the European Union.

## **The Estate:**

Winemaker Daniel Haegi began making wine in 1985 and is the 3rd generation Haegi to make wines on this tiny farm in Mittelbergheim, Alsace. Grapes are organically grown with a great respect to native and traditional methods. Riesling, Gewurztraminer, Sylvaner, Pinot Blanc, Pinot Noir and Pinot Gris are the main grapes grown here. The winery produces less than 7,000 cases per year in total. In 2013, Domaine Haegi was granted the Vin Biologique status. This is the European Union equivalent to certified organic.

## **Tasting Notes:**

**Color:** straw hued gold

**Aromas:** ripe nectarine, pear and floral notes

**Flavor & Texture:** juicy and bright with peach, green apple and subtle honey. The texture is round and medium bodied

**Food Pairing:** risotto with spring vegetables, fresh herbs and grated Parmesan cheese
