

2021 Elysian Sauvignon Blanc

Santa Ynez Valley, California



The Wine:

This 100% Sauvignon Blanc was made from grapes grown on the Mesa Verde vineyard in the Santa Ynez Valley of Santa Barbara country. The cooling influence of the Pacific Ocean, only a few miles away, keeps the vines vibrant and healthy and produces wines with great acidity and ripe fruit flavors. Fermented and aged in stainless steel with occasional stirring of the lees to bring out flavor and aromatic intensity. There were only 59 cases made.

The Project:

Elysian wines are the result of a partnership between Joshua Klapper and Quigley Fine Wines to produce unique and terroir driven wines from California's central coast, with an emphasis on Santa Barbara County. Our partnership with Josh Klapper was formed from a mutual philosophy on wine and winemaking. Limited production wines from sustainable vineyards with minimal intervention, allowing the vineyard and the fruit to do the talking.

Tasting Notes:

Color: light golden hue

Aromas: citrus fruit, white flowers and hints of savory spice

Flavor & Texture: lime, tart apples and lemon rind. The body is crisp, clean and boosted by fresh acids

Food Pairing: grilled halibut served with a tropical fruit salsa
